

General Anesthesia in Dental Offices

Nebraska Medicaid update

Effective Aug. 1, 2025, the Nebraska Medicaid and Long-Term Care (MLTC) program will reimburse physician anesthesiologists and certified registered nurse anesthetists (CRNAs) for administering general anesthesia in dental office settings.

Who qualifies?

Patients classified under:

- ASA Class I
- · Some ASA Class II

Refer to American Society of Anesthesiologists Physical Status Classification System at **asahq.org** for details.

Why this matters

Expanding anesthesia services in dental offices improves access to dental care for eligible Medicaid patients.

Billing

- You do not need to change your billing or claim submission process for general anesthesia or how you treat dental patients
- Anesthesiologists and CRNAs must be enrolled with Nebraska Medicaid
- Use the current CMS-1500 professional claim form to bill the procedure codes listed below

CDT codes for anesthesia services

D9219: Evaluation for sedation or anesthesia

D9222: Deep sedation/general anesthesia - first 15 minutes

D9223: Deep sedation/general anesthesia - each additional 15 minutes

D9239: IV moderate sedation - first 15 minutes

D9243: IV moderate sedation - each additional 15 minutes your practice while closing gaps in care.
