

Earn money with the TennCare Maternity Quality Care initiative

To support the work you do to help improve health outcomes for mothers and babies, we're offering your practice the opportunity to receive a payment for using certain reporting codes for prenatal and postnatal care visits. Maternity incentive payments are based on specific informational codes and do not impact contracted reimbursement of other claim codes.

Prenatal visits

You'll receive a \$25 administrative reimbursement when you report a 0500F CPT® category II code at the first prenatal visit. Take these steps to receive it:

- Bill first prenatal care visit with 0500F and the appropriate evaluation and management (E&M) CPT Code (99202-99205 or 99211-99215)
- Submit at least \$25 in billed charges for 0500F
- Fill out Obstetrics/Pregnancy Risk Assessment Form (OBRAF)
 - o For print version: Go to UHCprovider.com> Resources > Choose a Location > TN > Medicaid (Community Plan) > Provider Forms, Resources and References United HealthCare Community Plan of Tennessee > Provider Forms > OBRAF. Fax the form to 877-353-6913 within 30 days of the first prenatal care visit.
 - o For online version: Go to <u>UHCprovider.com</u> and sign in to the UnitedHealthcare Provider Portal using your One Healthcare ID and password. Select Clinical and Pharmacy and then Care Conductor and Notification of Pregnancy. Enter the required information and complete the OBRAF on the last page.

Postpartum visits

You can receive up to 2 administrative reimbursement payments of \$75 by taking the following steps:

- Bill first postpartum care visit with 0503F and the postpartum code 59430
- Submit at least \$75 in billed charges for 0503F
- Complete up to 2 postpartum care visits within 84 days of delivery

Mental health screening

You can receive an enhanced reimbursement if you:

- Bill screening services with 96160 + TH modifier
- Submit at least \$15 in billed charges for 96160 + TH
- Complete a mental health risk assessment as part of the member's prenatal and/or postpartum care
