



New required uniform coordination of benefits questionnaire

As of Feb. 1, 2026, the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) will require all applicable health plans to use state mandated uniform Coordination of Benefits (COB) questionnaires. This is directed by [House Bill 388](#) and is implemented through [28 Texas Administrative Code §3.3520](#).

What this means for you

As of Feb. 1, 2026, TDI requires the use of 2 standardized forms for reporting other health coverage:

- [LHL138 – Patient Health Plan Coverage](#) (completed by providers)
- [LHL139 – Enrollee's Other Health Plan Coverage](#) (completed by members)
