**Long-acting Reversible Contraception Products Abandoned Unit Return
Forms**

Background:

Long-acting reversible contraception (LARC) products are available to clients through either Medicaid pharmacy or medical benefit. Manufacturers offer abandoned unit return programs allowing prescribers to return an abandoned LARC product with an abandoned unit return form.

Key Details:

The updated Organon product abandoned unit return form, along with other LARC-related manufacturer forms, are available on the VDP website.

Additional Information:

MCOs should communicate information about the buy-back program to prescribers in their networks.
