Anatomical Modifier Requirement Policy, Professional	August 1, 2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The new Anatomical Modifier Requirement Policy, Professional will be effective for dates of service on or after August 1, 2023. UnitedHealthcare will align with CMS by creating a new professional Anatomical Modifier Requirement policy which will provide correct coding requirements for appending anatomical modifiers to CPT codes representing percutaneous coronary intervention procedures. The following modifiers are used to identify the different part of the body where the specific percutaneous coronary intervention procedure is performed. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> LC LD LM RC RI
Device and Skin Substitute Policy, Facility	August 1, 2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> UnitedHealthcare Individual Family Plan will align with CMS by creating a new Device and Skin Substitute Policy, Facility that will be effective for dates of service on or after August 1, 2023. When a device- dependent procedure code is submitted, the appropriate device code must be submitted on the same claim for the same date of service unless the procedure was terminated. The submission of certain skin substitute application procedures requires the appropriate skin substitute product be submitted on the same day. These procedures and products are divided into two lists based on high or low cost.
